Using machine embroidery and reverse appliqué techniques James takes freehand machine embroidery to another depth. Exploring themes in society and everyday life that we sometimes chose to ignore. His portraits of people in society usually seen in a negative light are arrestingly softened by the media skill and colours he carefully chooses for each piece. They reach out emotionally with humour and a raw edge, always questioning, stunningly beautiful and sometimes giving the appearance of stained glass. David exhibited 'Fallen Angel' for the first time at the 'New Designers' show in Islington in July 2012 to much acclaim. 
